### TOGETHER...WE MADE IT HAPPEN

SAVICE is proud to announce that the children's scholarship fund for 2008-2009 school year was distributed on 31/12/08 to a total of 384 qualified students. Additionally, SAVICE funded the building of the first school with two classrooms in Kon H'Rinh Village, Cur Mgar District, Daklak Province in Vietnam. The inauguration of the school was held on 9/13/08, to launch the 2008-2009 school year.

Quoc Vu, who monitored the construction of the new school, spoke at the inauguration.

Cu Mgar, meaning Hill of Flowers, is a mountainous district, about 50 km from central Ban Me Thuoc. During the Vietnam War, the place was dominated by the Nationalist troops during the day and by the Communists at night. Although the war was over 30 years ago, the evidence of war still remains in the area. Poverty and illiteracy exist in the villages. SAVICE chose this village to build its first school for the underprivileged children.

When we first came here, the road to get to the village was muddy and slippery due to rain a few days before, so our motorbikes were crawling slowly. It reached a point where we had to get off our motorbikes and walk in the mud to get here. Once here, we were greeted by volunteers from Quang Nhieuh Parish and about 200 children of various ages. The celebration started with

songs, speeches, and a showing of appreciation to SAVICE and its sponsors and donors who made their dream come true. The school building was decorated with two banners that read: "Lop Mau Giao Tinh Thuong" and

"Thanh Le Lam Phep Khanh Thanh Lop Mau Giao Tinh Thuong," which means "Classroom of Love" and "Celebrating Mass for the Opening of the Classrooms of Love." This school building is probably now the most beautiful structure that anyone has ever seen in this village. The children, whose damaged hair and skin reflects their extensive exposure to the sun during their heavy daily workload in the field, had been waiting for us. Their innocent eyes sparkled with joy, and they filled the day with smiles and laughter, in spite of their badly worn clothes. The classrooms had been a long awaited dream for them. Adults from all over, including those from the neighboring villages and local authorities came, to live the experience they too had long been dreaming of – the experience of physically seeing a classroom in their own village for their children.

Not to worry anymore of the long commute, poor hygiene and safety conditions of the previous under-constructed narrow classroom that their children used to go to. After the mass the celebration ended with the distribution of various goodie bags to all attendees.

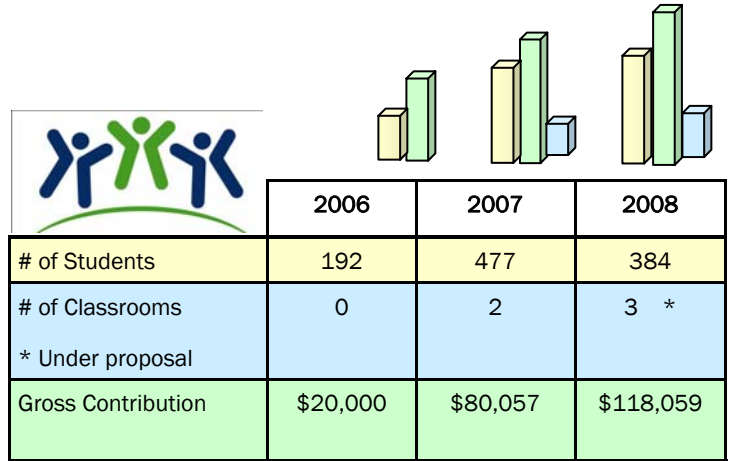
